Dear families,

Starting infant/primary school

For children born between 1 September 2019 and 31 August 2020. Application deadline: 15 January 2024.

Apply for a place in a reception class >

Transfer to junior school

For children born between 1 September 2016 and 31 August 2017 (attending an infant school in Cornwall). **Application deadline: 15 January 2024.**

Apply for a place in year 3 in a junior school >

Transfer to secondary school

For children born between 1 September 2012 and 31 August 2013. Application deadline: 31 October 2023.

Apply for a place in year 7 in a secondary school >
