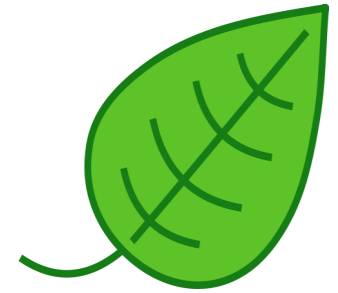
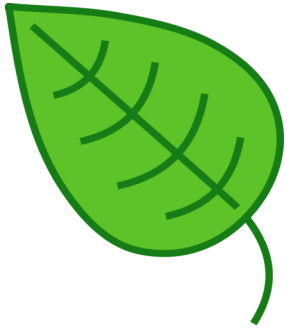


# Rainforests
