Biomes and Vegetation

| Biome | A naturally occurring area of flora and fauna occupying a major habitat. |
|------------------------|--|
| Tundra | A vast, flat, treeless level found in cold regions. Often covered in snow and found at the tops of mountains. |
| Desert | Dry land with less than 25cm of rainfall per year. Deserts can be very hot or very cold with very little vegetation. |
| Savanna | A grassy plain with widely spaced trees, allowing the sun to reach the grass. |
| Vegetation | A group of plant species specific to a certain area or habitat. |
| Equator | An imaginary line drawn around the middle of the Earth, dividing it into the Northern and Southern hemispheres. |
| Tropic of Cancer | The line of latitude to the north of the equator. |
| Tropic of Capricorn | The line of latitude to the south of the equator. |

Desert (Cold)

Conditions: Snowy, icy cold. Precipitation annually: less than 25.4cm

Average temperature: -40° - 0°C Fauna: Polar bears and seals.

Flora: dwarf trees giving way to grasses (mainly mosses, lichen, sedges, and some flowering plants)

Desert (Hot)

Conditions: Dry biome Precipitation annually: less

than 25cm.

Average temperature: 38°C Fauna: Camels and scorpions.

Flora: Cacti, small bushes, short grasses.

Tundra

Conditions: cold, rocky biome which is often covered in snow.

Average Temperature: -40°C - 18°C Precipitation annually: 15 - 25cm

Fauna: Artic foxes, mountain goats and wolves. Flora: shrubs, grasses, mosses, sedges, and lichens.

Savanna

Conditions: Summer and a winter. Average Temperature: 25°C

Precipitation annually: 76 -101cm Fauna: Zebras, giraffes and lions.

Flora: Acacia, baobab, pine, palm.

Coniferous Forest

Conditions: Winters are long, cold and dry, while the short summers are moderately warm and moist

Average Temperature: -40°C - 20°C Precipitation annually: 30cm - 90cm Fauna: Bears, eagles and moose.

Flora: Coniferous evergreen trees which don't lose their

leaves in the autumn.

Deciduous Forest

Conditions: Warm summers, cold

winters

Average Temperature: -20°C-30°C

Precipitation annually: 75cm - 150cm Fauna: Badgers, squirrels and hedgehogs.

Flora: Oak trees, maple trees, beech trees, mountain

laurel, azaleas.

Rainforest

Conditions: Warm, wet and humid. Average Temperature: 20°C - 25°C Precipitation annually: 250-400cm Fauna: Jaquars, sloths and monkeys.

Flora: Orchid, cacao, baobab, oil palm.

Grasslands (Steppe)

Conditions: Extremely hot in summer. Average Temperature: 20°C - 30°C Precipitation annually: 50cm - 90cm Fauna: Coyotes, bison and antelope.

Flora: Variety of grasses, sunflower, milkweed, wild

indigo.
