- 1) Welcome – Everybody introduced themselves to the group.
- 2) Mrs King Showed a video of children at NP talking about their rights and how these had made a difference to them at school
- 3) Talked about rights day which is going to be held at St Stephens and Windmill to promote the convention – Activities to include wants and needs activity, peer mediators, posters, photographs of charter (RRSA steering group children to photograph charters), thinking tree, Rights tree, Letters to Scott Mann, rights slips, rights champion, rights , JRSO, every child books, mascot, rights snap,
- 4) Staff meeting to be held at St Stephens with Windmill – videos to be shown of children about how rights have impacted on school life
- 5) Rights Learning Walk – Lots of positives. Area for improvement – how we can represent articles around school. Ideas included linking an article to each display. Reminding in lessons. Teachers to include in their planning. Have a list of key rights in class for teachers to refer to. Special day person could try to remember a right or a reflection at the end of each day to review the rights we have had reflected. Rights child of the week could choose a right that is meaningful to them and share with the class.
- 6) Invite press to road show, invite parents and governors
- 7) Next steps – Go to Launceston College, home school partnerships, The Virtual school, to spread the word
