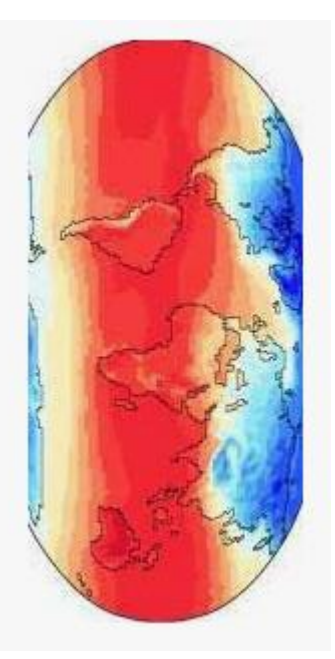




Class 2 Curriculum Autumn 2021



History
